Suzuki applied the principles of learning a language to learning music, and made careful listening, repetition, teaching a little at a time, and positive reinforcement the cornerstones of his lesson plans.

To date, more than 100,000 children all over the world are trained by Suzuki's method. The Suzuki Method has since been applied to other instruments including cello, viola, flute, piano and guitar. ## Program Description

### Suzuki Method for ages 3 & up
